



OAC PAYMENT PLAN AGREEMENT

Okanagan Athletics Club offers a free Payment Plan option to OAC parents and athletes in all training groups, other than the Track Rascals Program.

Opting for the Payment Plan option at the time of registration allows OAC Training Fees to be spread out equally over each month of the training season. The Fall/Winter training season consists of 6 equal payments, September to February, inclusive. The Spring/Summer training season consists of 5 equal payments, March to July, inclusive.

Administrative Fees

There are **no** administrative fees added to use a Payment Plan.

Payment Schedule

- The first payment is due at the time of registration, prior to the start of the first practice.
- The remaining payments are due on the first day of each month.

Missed Payments

If the first payment is not received prior to the start of the first practice, the athlete will not be permitted to proceed to practice.

If a payment is not received by the first day of each month, the athlete will be given a 3-day window to settle the outstanding amount.

Club Withdrawal

OAC's Refund Policy must be adhered to by all parents and athletes, including those who have opted for the Payment Plan payment option. Should an athlete initiate a refund request that is declined by OAC Club Executive, the agreed upon payment plan, must continue, even if the athlete chooses to withdrawal from Okanagan Athletics Club prior to the end of the training season. If a partial refund is approved, the difference may still be required, depending on the amount of the refund and payments already made.

The Payment Plan payment option in no way waives any obligation for full payment of registration fees, BCA fees and Raffle Tickets pre-purchased.

If a parent or athlete default in a payment of OAC registration fees for any reason whatsoever, the parent/athlete is liable for all costs and expenses incurred in collecting the same, including, but not limited to, reasonable attorney's fees, collection fees and court costs.

OAC has adopted a "No Pay, No Play" policy, whereby OAC fees that have not been paid in full (or whereby a pre-approved payment plan is not in place) by the athlete's first training session of the season, that athlete will NOT be permitted to train and/or compete in OAC meets. Additionally, any athlete with outstanding fees from any previous season(s) will not be permitted to train and/or compete in OAC meets unless the outstanding amount is paid in full.
